

Roger Rehr, W3SZ, was first licensed in 1968 as WN3JYM. He got his Advanced license a year later, but didn't get around to getting his Extra AA3QK until the mid 1990s. He then got the vanity call W3SZ to honor both his alma mater Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute W2SZ, and the great contesting team W2SZ/1. He was an inactive amateur from 1974 until the early 1990s, when he became interested in satellites, then EME, then DSP, and finally terrestrial microwaves. He is active with 144 MHz and 10 GHz EME and also with terrestrial weak signal work 50 MHz thru 24 GHz.
